Spigot/Hose Bib ¾" Female Bulkhead Fitting	\$5.50
Overflow 1 ½" Female Bulkhead Fitting (optional)	\$5.50
¾" Quarter-turn Male Hose Bib	\$7.98
Irrigation Drain	\$7.48
1 ½" Overflow Barbed Adapter (optional)	\$0.78

There is no single way to convert a drum into a rain barrel. There are many different options and configurations.

!-All opening to the outside of the barrel must either be shut off (i.e., sillcock/hose bib) or screened to prevent mosquitoes from gaining access. **This is important in order to stay compliant with municipal and neighborhood codes.**

!-For optimal performance and compliance with this program, all barrels must be drained in the next stretch of dry weather consecutive to a rain event. The object of this program is to detain the storm water, not hold it for weeks on end.

THIS PROGRAM IS INTENDED ONLY FOR AREAS WHERE RAIN BARRELS ARE PERMITTED. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE INDIVIDUAL RECEIVING THE BARREL TO INVESTIGATE AND REMAIN COMPLIANT WITH REGIONAL, MUNICIPAL AND NEIGHBORHOOD CODES CONCERNING RAIN BARRELS, THEIR PLACEMENT AND MAINTENANCE. BY ENGAGING IN THIS PROGRAM, YOU AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THE APPLICABLE STIPULATIONS.

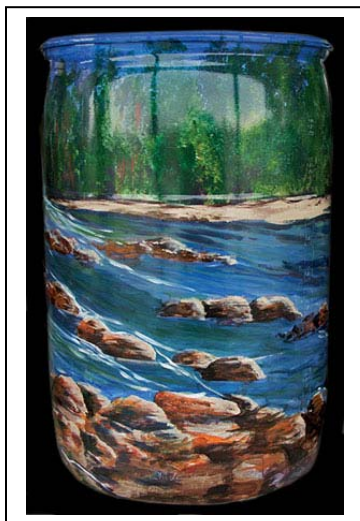
